What does my day at MNSOM look like?

The following schedule is to give you a broad idea of what a day at MNSOM is like. Your instructor uses this as a **guideline** but is open to change to best meet the size, needs of the class and teaching the topic.

- **8:00 am - 8:30 am: Arrival, Registration and Turning in Homework**
 - It is **essential** that all students promptly arrive at the location and be and ready to begin at 8:30am. Attendance is mandatory for the **entire** day and counts as **20% of your final grade.**
 - Enter Place of Hope on the backside of the building. There are 2 entrances to the building. The entrance on the right is used in the winter/cold weather and the entrance on the left is used in fairer weather. Look for the gazebo and follow the sidewalk into the building. Upon arrival, go up the stairs to the chapel. Upon entering the room, you will sign in, obtain your nametag, and turn in **2** copies of any paper copies of homework if required.
 - For classes where homework/ quizzes are completed online, it may be helpful to bring a printout of the quiz questions with your answers to ask any questions that you may have about the homework. **IMPORTANT!** If your homework /quizzes for your class are completed online, quizzes **need to be completed by Noon on the Friday before class.** Grades will be pulled from online and given to the instructor.
 - If class is cancelled due to inclement weather, we will contact you via email and also post it on our Facebook page.
- **8:30am - 9:15am: Worship, Announcements and Devotions.**
 - The day begins with students from both classes in the chapel. The day begins with Worship, announcements and devotions. This is mandatory to fulfill the attendance requirements for the day. A mid-morning brunch is provided for students by Place of Hope and will be announced at chapel. Some students find it helpful to pack and bring along a snack to eat in the early afternoon. If you have any special dietary needs, it is best to bring a bag lunch.
- **9:00am -10:30am: Students break into separate classroom areas.**
 - Students move from the chapel area to your designated class area for their individual classes. Directions will be given in chapel.
 - Once in the classroom, Homework assignments will be corrected (if *not* done online) followed by review for the final exam.
- **10:30am -11:30am:** Brunch provided.
- **11:30am -12:30am:** Take and grade Final Exam.
- **12:30pm-3:30pm:** Instructor led lecture, discussion, and exercises on the course topic.
