

Cloquet Saturday MNSOM Schedule Located at Good Hope Church 55 Armory Rd. S., Cloquet, MN 55720

What does a day at MNSOM class in Cloquet look like?

The following schedule is to give you a broad idea of what a MNSOM day is like. Your instructor uses this as a *guideline* but is open to change to best meet the size, needs of the class and teaching the topic.

- 8:00 am 8:30 am: Arrival, Registration and Turning in Homework
 - It is <u>essential</u> that all students promptly arrive at the location and be and ready to begin at 8:30am. Attendance is mandatory for the <u>entire</u> day and counts as 20% of your final grade.
 - Enter Good Hope Church through the main doors of the building. Upon arrival, you will see a sign directing you to the class location. Upon entering the room, you will sign in on the attendance sign-in sheet, obtain your nametag, and turn in <u>1</u> copy of any typed-out paper copies of homework if a specific course requires it. Approximately half of the MNSOM classes (Faith & Action textbooks) require homework to be turned in online. You will find it helpful to bring a printout of the quiz questions that you took online with your answers to class to ask any questions that you may have about the homework.
 - IMPORTANT! If your homework /quizzes for your class are required to be completed online, Text Overview answers <u>need to be entered online by Noon on the Friday before</u> class. MNSOM will pull the grades from Moodle and give to the instructor before class.
 - If class is cancelled due to inclement weather, you will be contacted via email and posted on our MNSOM Facebook page. Most likely the class will be conducted on Zoom and you will attend from your home. Please like and follow us on Facebook.
- 8:30am 9:15am: Worship and Devotions, Announcements and awarding Class Completion Certificates from previous classes.
 - The day begins with students from both classes in the chapel. The day begins with Worship, announcements and devotions. This is mandatory to fulfill the General Council's attendance requirements for the day to qualify for credentials. If you have any special dietary needs, such as gluten-free, it is best to bring a bag lunch.
- 9:15am -11:30am: Students break into separate classroom areas.
 - After chapel, class begins. Homework questions will be discussed and clarified. Homework Assignments will be corrected for classes requiring typed-out paper copies. For classes where the quizzes are entered online, questions may also be asked and answered at this appointed time. The final exam will be given after review. A brief health break will be given preceding the final test.
- 11:30am -12:30am: Lunch with students and instructor.
- **12:30pm-3:30pm:** Instructor led lecture, discussion, or exercises on the course topic.
- 3:30 pm Dismissal

What do I bring to class?

A Bible, Notebook/laptop for notes, pen/pencil, the textbook and an open, teachable spirit.
