What does my day at MNSOM look like?

The following schedule is to give you a broad idea of what a day at MNSOM is like. Your instructor uses this as a *guideline* but is open to change to best meet the size, needs of the class and teaching the topic.

- 8:00 am 8:30 am: Arrival, Check-in and Turning in Homework, Light Breakfast
 - It is <u>essential</u> that all students promptly arrive at the location and be and ready to begin at 8:30am. Attendance is mandatory for the <u>entire</u> day and counts as 20% of your final grade. No, you may not leave early. Do not ask.
 - Upon entering the chapel room, you will sign in, obtain your nametag, and turn in one copy of any paper copies of homework if the class requires it. (If not done online.)
 - For classes where Text Overview homework is completed on Moodle (Faith & Action textbooks), bring a printout of the questions with your answers to ask any questions that you may have about the homework and to use during the review. <u>IMPORTANT! If your text overview for your class is required to be submitted online, it must be by Noon on Friday the day before class.</u> You may not attend class if homework is not done on time. Grades will be pulled from online and given to the instructor that afternoon.
 - For classes with Word document homework, type answers and bring a printed copy to turn in at registration (given back to you during class to use).
 - If class is switched to Zoom due to inclement weather or other complications, we will contact you via email.
- 8:30am 9:15am: Worship, Announcements and Devotions.
- The day begins with students from both classes in the chapel. The day begins with worship, announcements, handing out certificates of classes completed and devotions. This is mandatory to fulfill the attendance requirements for the day. If you have any special dietary needs, it is best to bring a bag lunch.
- 9:15am -11:00am: Students break into separate classroom areas.
 - Students move from the chapel area to your designated class area for their individual classes. Directions will be given in chapel.
 - Once in the classroom, Text Overview homework will be corrected (or reviewed if submitted online) followed by a few quiet minutes to review for the final exam.
- 11:00-11:45 Take and grade Final Exam.
- **11:45am- 12:30pm:** Approximate Lunch Break delivered (If you have any special dietary needs, it is best to bring a bag lunch.)
- 12:30pm-3:30pm: Instructor-led lecture, discussion, and exercises on the course topic.
- 3:30 pm: Dismissal
